Enrolment Scheme

Worser Bay School has experienced significant roll growth over the last year and this has put our accommodation capacity under pressure. Therefore, the Ministry of Education has implemented an Enrolment Scheme because of real concern about the threat of overcrowding at the school.

The Enrolment Scheme started operating at the beginning of Term 4, 2008. Attached to this notice is a full description of the Enrolment Scheme. This means that children from families who live within the home zone have the right to enrol at the school. All other enrolments will be subject to the Enrolment Scheme Legislation.

The scheme must establish the following order of priority for the selection of students who live outside the school's home zone:

First Priority:	Students accepted for enrolment in a special programme run by the School and approved by the Secretary of Education. We have no such programmes, so this priority does not apply to us.
Second Priority:	Siblings of current students
Third Priority:	Siblings of former students
Fourth Priority:	Children of Board Employees
Fifth Priority:	All other students

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group must be by ballot.

Worser Bay School Home Zone:

Clockwise from Worser Bay Surf Club.

South to Beere Haven Steps.

Up Beere Haven Steps, houses on both sides to Sinclair Street, both sides.

Beere Haven Road, both sides, to intersection with Seatoun Heights Road, both sides, including Stormanstown Way both sides to Tio Tio Road intersection.

From Seatoun Heights/Tio Tio Road intersection directly down to Broadway at the mouth of the tunnel. All houses on the northern side of Broadway to Wilberforce Street.

Both sides of Wilberforce Street including all side roads.

Both sides of Townsend Road to its intersection with Athens Street.

Athens Street, eastern side of steps, comprising address numbers 24 and above on the even side and 19 and above on the odd side.

Both sides Townsend Road from its intersection with Athens Street to Awa Road intersection.

Both sides Awa Road from Para Street intersection to Totara Road intersection.

Both sides Totara Road to Nevay Road intersection, not including Darlington Terrace.

Both sides Nevay Road to Wellington Prison.

Straight line to Scorching Bay.

Scorching Bay south to Worser Bay Surf Club.
