School Swimming Sports

Worser Bay School will be holding its Annual Swimming Sports in the second week of Term 3. These will be held in two events over two separate dates.

The first date, **Tuesday, 27th July - 10am to 11.30am**, will be more of a competitive event where students can trial for the Eastern Zones' Swimming Sports. This event will be held in the 2 metre pool and is open to Year 3 - 6 students **who can comfortably swim 25 metres**. If your child wishes to participate in the Eastern Zones trials, please fill in the relevant part of the permission slip below to confirm they are able to swim 25 metres. (Students without permission will be unable to trial.)

The second half of this event will be fun relays and other swimming races. These will be held in the 1.2 metre pool for students in **Māhutonga** who do not feel comfortable in the 2 metre pool. Please contact your child's teacher if your child is not confident enough to swim in this pool.

The second date, **Thursday, 29th July - 12.15pm to 1.15pm**, will be a fun event where **Tautoru and Autahi** will combine forces for fun-filled water activities and races in the Splash pool. Again, please feel free to contact us if you have any concerns.

The cost is **\$5.00 per child** for bus hire and pool entry.

Parents and other family members are welcome to come and join in the fun and support the children. (Please note: the Aquatic Centre charges \$1.00 for spectators.)

If you are able to act as a parent helper and can assist with judging races or getting students changed (Tautoru and Autahi), please let your child's teacher know. Your help would be much appreciated.
